CHAPTER 6 - PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING A LICENSE

001. This chapter is adopted pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. '48-1708.

002. A license may be applied for as follows:

- A. File a completed application on forms supplied by the Division. In the case of a partnership, corporation or cooperative association, each individual having a financial interest in the business must complete and file a separate application form.
- B. File with the application proof of financial ability to pay wages and advances. Such proof may be a corporate surety bond, a cash deposit or a deposit the equivalent of cash.
- C. File any assumed business name and corporate name with the Secretary of State.
- D. All forms, documents and other required information shall be filed with the Division.
- E. Submit two identical passport size photos (2"x2") of each person applying for a licensing identification card.
- F. If a corporation or cooperative association, be authorized to conduct business in Nebraska.
