

## NEBRASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

TITLE 228 - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

CHAPTER 6 - INSURANCE

001. This chapter is adopted pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. ' 48-1803.
002. No person shall be issued a permit to operate a ride under this chapter unless, at the time of operation, the owner has an insurance policy in effect written by an insurance company authorized to do business in this state. In the case of all amusement rides other than bungee jumping operations, such policies shall provide coverage in an amount of not less than one-hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for bodily injury to or death of one person in any one accident and, subject to the limit for one person, in an amount of not less than three-hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for injury to or destruction of property of others in any one accident insuring the owner/operator against liability for injury or death suffered by a person attending a carnival, fair, or amusement park. In the case of permits issued for bungee jumping operations, the minimum amounts of insurance shall be not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for each accident.
003. If the insurance is suspended, cancelled, or expires and/or if the amusement ride owner/operator changes insurance companies, the amusement ride owner/operator shall notify the Department of Labor and submit proof of insurance coverage to the Commissioner immediately or operations will be discontinued and permit(s) previous issued will be revoked without further notice to the owner/operator. After permit(s) have been revoked, the amusement ride owner/operator must reapply with the Department of Labor.
